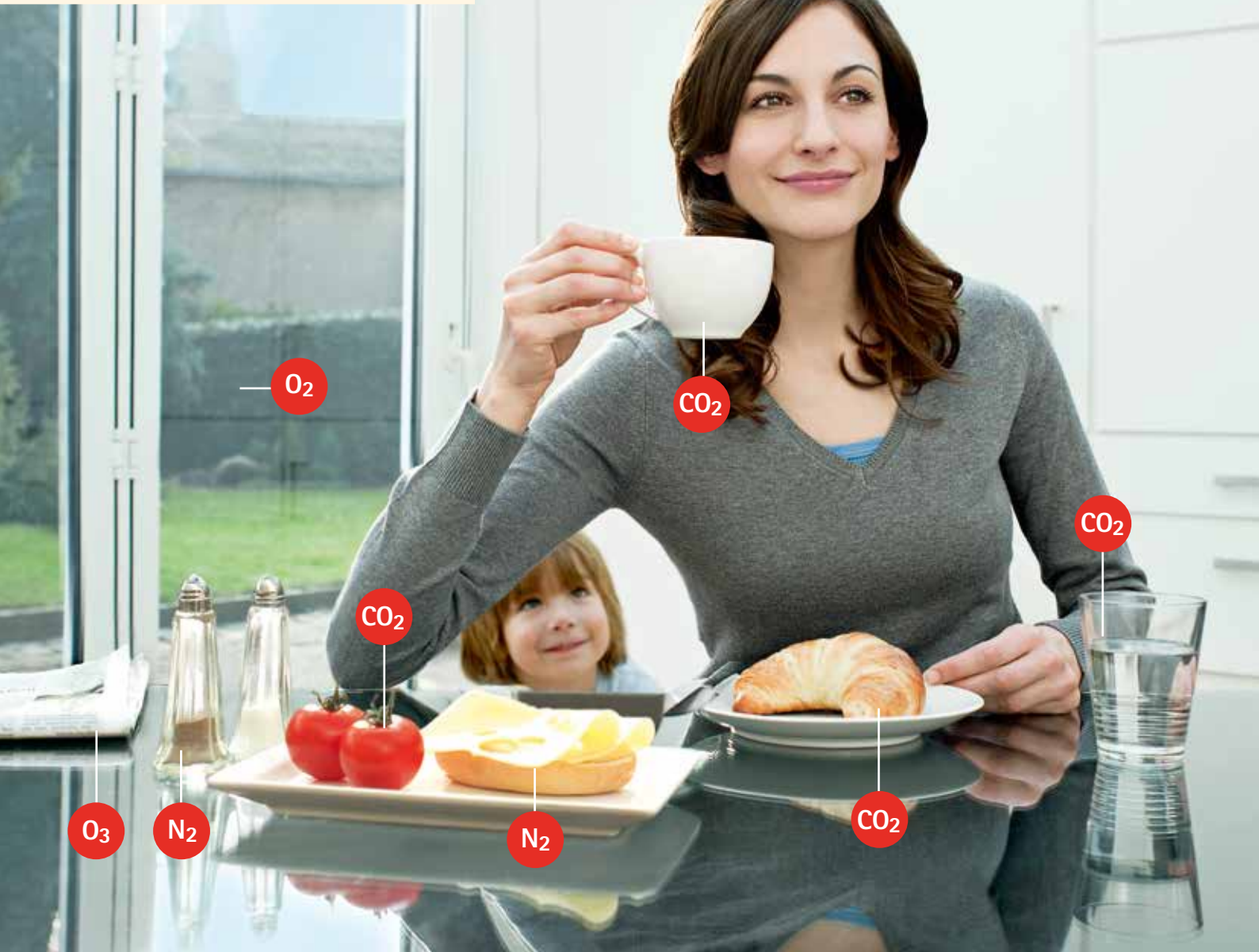


Four **Gases for Life.**

Messer produces and supplies industrial gases for all areas of everyday life. Even if our **Gases for Life** cannot be seen, they have no reason to hide. Nitrogen (**N<sub>2</sub>**) is, for example, used for the cold grinding of spices and as a protective gas when packaging cheese, while carbon dioxide (**CO<sub>2</sub>**) is employed for greenhouse fertilisation, cooling dough and the decaffeination of coffee – and, of course, for carbonating drinks. Oxygen (**O<sub>2</sub>**) is used in glass production, and ozone (**O<sub>3</sub>**) for bleaching paper.
